2025 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Livestock exhibitors must be the property of the exhibitor for at least two monthsprior to the Show.
- ² All exhibitors must pay admission to the Show.
- . The Show Society acting through its Officers may refuse entry.
- 3 The Show Society while cataloguing the exhibits will not accept liability
- for any error in the numbering of exhibits, for any exhibit not being
- 4 displayed, or loss of, accident or damage to any exhibit.
- 5. The Judges may withhold a prize in class in which, in their opinion, there is not sufficient merit. The Judges decision to 'merit' will be final.
- 6. Subject to the Judge's decision, no prize will be awarded in a class unless there are at least two exhibits. No second prize unless there are four exhibits and no third prize unless there are six exhibits.
- 7.In classes where there are ten or more entries, the Judges may award an additional prize, if exhibits in their opinion warrant it. In the case of only one exhibit in a class, the Judge may award a merit prize if the exhibit in his opinion warrants it.
- 8. No exhibit will be removed from the Show Grounds without permission from the Chief Steward, whose name will appear in the Show Catalogue.
- Any statement of ownership wrongly, intentionally, or otherwise made on the Entry Form (in the opinion of the Committee) automatically disqualifies the exhibitor.
- 10. Any objections regarding a Class or Classes must be lodged in writing with the secretary within half an hour of judging of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of €20.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained or considered to be frivolous.
- 11. The society reserves the right to postpone any Show or part thereof, definitely of indefinitely, without incurring any liability to any exhibitor or any other party.
- 12. To avoid any confusion regarding Perpetual Cups at Ballyshannon Show, a Perpetual Cup goes on forever and cannot be won outright.
- 13. All entries must be received on or before the **Friday 2nd August 2025**. No late entries will be accepted. Entry fees must be paid when entering; otherwise, the entry will not be accepted.
- _{14.} All cups must be returned to the Society by **1st July 2025**.
- 15.An exhibitor will not be awarded more than two first prizes with the same animal.
- 16. Any incorrect entries for Classes in the Horse & Pony section will be disqualified.
- 17. All cattle must comply with the Department of Agriculture test regulations.
- 18. No Steward can officiate in a ring who is an exhibitor or family member of an exhibitor or family member of an exhibitor.
- 19. Any exhibitor found to be intimating judges/stewards will be removed from the show, not receive any prize money and will also receive a 2 year ban from exhibiting at the Ballyshannon Agricultural Show.
- 20. The show committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes if insufficient entries.

- 21. The Show Committee will collect Championship Fund Levy (currently 5%) from Horse, Pony, Cattle and Sheep class prize money for the year 2025 and forward to ISA as required.
- 22. No Animal can win more than one Red Rosette on the day with the exemption of Breed Championship Finals, Super Calf Classes and All Ireland Finals.
- 23. Rosettes are not allowed to be displayed on entries into classes.

Important Notice to Animal Owners Involved in the Show The Irish

Shows Association would advise all animal owners who have their animals insured to have the insurance cover extended to cover them while showing animals at shows. We understand that it costs very little, or nothing at all, to do so, depending on who you have your insurance cover with.

If you are one of the few people who does not have cover, we would advise that you think about putting it in place for this purpose. It may well be worthwhile.

The reason for us giving you this advice is to protect yourself in the event of your animal lashing out and injuring someone or damaging someone's property. If that were to happen, and it is established that your animal was out of your control, you may be held fully or partly responsible for any injury or damage caused and may end up paying all or part of any settlement reached.

Message from Dara Calleary TD Minister for Rural and Community Development and the Gaeltacht

CATTLE SECTION

Animal Identificationand Movement (AIM) Notification

- 1. The movement of cattle to and from an Agricultural Show/Fair within the State must be recorded on the AIM System.
- 2. With effect from 4 February 2019 there is a specific Certificates of Compliance for the "Movement of Bovine from a Single Holding to a Show", form NBAS 31K refers.
- 3. The herd keeper must obtain the Certificate of Compliance prior to the movement of animals. The certificate can be created by (i) applying on-line using their agfood account or (ii) where the keeper is not on-line the certificate can be generated by the local Regional Veterinary Office (RVO) following receipt of a completed form NBAS 31 K.
- 4. The creation of a certificate is subject to normal movement criteria such as clear TB test etc.
- 5. A copy of form NBAS 31K is included at Appendix 2 and will also be available on www.gov.ie.
- 6. When applying for this certificate, the Show/Fair number is not required. The certificate generated will include an "S" symbol.
- 7. The Certificate of Compliance for a show will continue to be valid for a period of up to 30 days. As is currently the case, these can be used for the movement of animal/s to several shows during the validity period of the certificate. Requests to the RVO should be provided with sufficient time to allow for the certificate to be generated and issued especially where one cert expires, and another is required immediately. Keepers who are likely to attend at consecutive shows are strongly advised to apply using herd keepers' on-line facility. The ability to create and print a certificate immediately (subject to the bovine meeting the relevant criteria) will remove issues which can arise where a certificate is already in place and a further certificate is required.
- 8. Calves which are less than 10 days old cannot be moved to a Show.
- 9. The Movement Notification Section of the Certificate should be completed and signed by the keeper. The form should also be signed and stamped by the Show Secretary who must clearly indicate the Show Number. The Show movement must be recorded on the passport. Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling these requirements lies with the Show Secretary.
- 10. If the animal/s move from the show to a herd other than the source herd, the new destination herd must also sign the certificate.
- 11. Completed forms must be sent by the Show Secretary to the local RVO within seven days of the Show. Failure to have movements recorded within the required time scale may have implications for the herd keeper/s involved.
